Summary: James 1: 2-3 says, "Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything."

- God leads us through the land we most want to avoid in order to produce in us that which we most desperately need.
- In your darkness, don't miss the opportunity to get to know God better.
