DISCUSSION POINTS:

- ❖ Am I living out my calling to be a follower in my church?
- ❖ Am I living out my calling to be a follower in my family?
- ❖ Is there enough evidence in my life to convict me of being a follower by the way I am loving those around me? (Friends, neighbors, co-workers, the cashier, the guy who cut you off, etc.)
- ❖ Is my heart broken for the things that break God's? What is God calling me into action about?
- ❖ As I look into the eyes of my brothers around the table, what do I need to confess? Where do I need accountability? What do I need for my brothers to pray about in terms of my character?
- ❖ Before you leave, pray for your brothers.

SUMMARY:

There is a rather large difference between knowing what God says and doing what God says. The difference between the two is at the heart of my relationship with God. Am I living out the calling I have received as a child of God or am I wasting my gift of grace?

A revolution has started. Am I a part of the solution or compounding the problem?
